2021-22 Fall Budget

The Board approved the EIPS 2021-22 Fall Budget that operates for the period of September 1, 2021 to August 31, 2022. Updated student enrollment numbers, revenue changes, actual carry forward amounts, expenses and planned reserve spending are considered in this approval process.

EIPS operating budget is \$198.26 million Student enrollment – 17124 EIPS employees – 1305.75 FTE
